



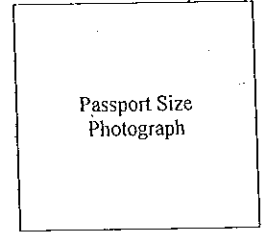

**Guidelines Governing the Entrance Test
For
Admission in the M.Phil. Courses of Ranchi University**

Applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria as in Regulation 4.1 seeking admission to the M.Phil. Courses of Ranchi University shall be required to appear at the M.Phil. Entrance Test. Total number of seats in M.Phil. Course will be 10(Ten) in each subject. The reservation rules of the Government of Jharkhand shall be strictly followed in the admissions.


- The Entrance Test shall be of two hours duration carrying 100 marks.
- There will be 100 multiple choice objective type questions each carrying one mark. The questions shall be set from compulsory theory papers only of the M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. Syllabus of Ranchi University.
- Question paper of Entrance Test shall be set in Hindi and English both except the question papers of Language subject in which the papers shall be set in the languages concerned.

**REGULATION
FOR
ONE YEAR FULL TIME M.PHIL. COURSE OF
RANCHI UNIVERSITY**

1. Objective

The objective of introducing the M.Phil. course in all University Departments from the academic year of 2012-13 is to provide opportunity to students to acquire the knowledge needed for scientific research. M.Phil. is the first research degree. Candidates offering M.Phil. programme shall be trained both in theory and report writing to enable them to pursue research leading to the Ph.D. degree. It will have both course and research components and will give the students adequate background for advanced research.

2. Duration and Place

2.1 The duration of the M.Phil. course will be of one academic year (July-June). The whole programme is divided into two semesters each of six months i.e. Semester-I (July to December) & Semester-II (January to June).

2.2 The M.Phil. course in all the subjects shall be conducted at the University Department of the subject concerned. The Academic Council and Syndicate of the University have granted permission for starting M.Phil. course in all University Departments from the academic year 2012-13 vide resolution No. 1(क) dated 23.03.2012 and resolution No. 557/12(क) dated 31.03.2012 respectively.

3. Number of Seats

3.1 The total number of seats in M.Phil. course will be 10 (ten) in each subject.

4. Eligibility and Procedure for Admission

4.1 Eligibility Criteria:

A Candidate must have obtained Master Degree in the subject concerned with at least 55% marks in the aggregate or an equivalent grade for General and OBC category and only 50% marks in aggregate or an equivalent grade for ST/SC category.

4.2 Procedure of Admission:

Students will be admitted in M.Phil. Course through an Entrance Test to be conducted by the University.

5. Reservation

5.1 The reservation rules of the Government of Jharkhand shall be strictly followed.

6. Attendance

- 6.1 The students admitted to the M.Phil. course shall be required to attend not less than 2/3rd (66.66 percent) of the total number of lectures delivered during the first semester period. Students having less than prescribed percentage of attendance shall not be allowed to appear at the university examination of semester-I. However in such cases final decision will be taken by the Departmental Research Council (DRC).

7. Course structure

- 7.1 There shall be three theory papers to be covered during the period of 1st semester (July - December). Student shall carry out dissertation work under the overall supervision of a supervisor/guide during the period of 2nd semester (January - June). He/She shall be required to present at least one paper in the seminar related to his/her dissertation in the department before submitting it to the Department for evaluation.
- 7.2 The detailed Courses of Studies of various subjects in M.Phil. Programme approved by the Board of Studies for the subjects in the concerned Department shall be followed in imparting M.Phil. course. But the course structure shall be the same for all subjects. The course structure shall consists of two components namely theory (300 marks) and dissertation (300 marks) as detailed below.

Note : - Paper-I shall include instruction on basics of computer application to make the students computer literate. However no questions will be set from this section in the examination of Paper - I.

8. Examination Rules

8.1 Scheme of examination/evaluation

The End Semester theory examinations of all three papers for seventy marks shall be conducted by the University sometime in December every year. The Continuous Internal Evaluation. System shall be followed for course works for providing quality education to the candidates. The thirty internal marks in each paper of the first semester shall be divided in three equal parts of ten marks each. The internal assessment shall be made by the department concerned. The thirty internal marks

shall be allotted to the students on the basis of their overall class attendance, performance in class tests and performance in home assignments as detailed below.

- (a) Ten marks will be awarded on the basis of the percentage of attendance of the candidate during the 1st Semester course. The month wise percentage of attendance as well as the aggregate percentage of attendance shall be displayed on the notice board of the concerned department to make it transparent. The marks will be awarded according to the aggregate percentage of class attendance at the end of 1st Semester.
- (b) Ten marks will be awarded on the basis of the performance in continuous evaluation. The monthly class tests shall be conducted thrice in 1st Semester preferably in the last week of the months in the class rooms. The best two of the three tests shall be considered for the allotment of marks i.e. the average of the two best marks. The department shall provide the blank answer books for monthly class tests. The evaluated answer books shall be shown to the students in the class and taken back for record.
- (c) Ten marks shall be awarded on the basis of the home assignments which will be three in number in one semester period. The best two of three shall be considered for the allotment of marks i.e. the average of the two best marks. The evaluated home assignment papers shall be returned back to the students in the class room keeping only the marks for record.

8.2 Submission and evaluation of dissertation

- (a) Every student who appeared at the Semester-I examination shall be allowed, without waiting for the result of Semester – I examination, to prepare the dissertation as partial fulfillment of the M.Phil. Degree. The Departmental Research Council (DRC) shall finalise the topic of dissertation and a supervisor to guide the student.
- (b) Every student, on completion of his/her dissertation work, shall submit it to the concerned department the three typed (or printed) bound copies of his/her dissertation embodying the result of his/her research work with three copies of abstract of about 500 words after presenting it in a seminar and approval of DRC.
- (c) The Dissertation will be evaluated by an external examiner appointed by the University on the recommendation of DRC.
- (d) The viva-voce test will be conducted in the concerned University Department by a committee consisting of
 - (i) The external examiner
 - (ii) The dissertation supervisor

8.3 Standard of Passing

- (a) 50% marks in each theory paper in Semester - I Examination.
- (b) 60% marks in dissertation and 60% marks in vive-voce separately in Semester-II
- (c) 60% marks in aggregate of the marks obtained in Semester-I and Semester-II.
- (d) A student who appeared at the 1st Semester examination shall be promoted (without waiting for the result) and allowed to pursue dissertation work. If he/she fails (on publication of result) at 1st Semester examination he/she be allowed to appear at the 2nd Semester examination. The degree will be awarded only if he/she clears the 1st Semester examination (of the next batch) and fulfils the requirement of 60% marks in aggregate.
- (e) Any student securing less than 60% marks in aggregate and less than 50% in each of the theory papers shall be treated as failed and shall have to repeat the course work and reappear in the examination of 1st semester (of the next batch) to secure 60% marks in aggregate.
- (f) If a student is found indulge in any kind of malpractice / use of unfair means, he / she shall be expelled for one academic year.

8.4 Award of class

- (a) First class with distinction : 75% of aggregate marks and above
- (b) First class : 65% of aggregate marks and above,
- (c) Second class : 60% of aggregate marks and above.

8.5 Award of Degree

The M.Phil. degree shall be awarded only after the successful completion (i.e. passing) of Semester-I and Semester-II examination with 60% marks in aggregate.

9. Fee Structure

9.1 Course Fee

The student will be required to pay an annual course fee of Rs. 1650/- at the time of his/her admission in the M.Phil. programme.

9.2 Examination Fee

The students will be required to pay the following fees.

- (i) Rs.600/- (Rs.300/- for Examination Fee & Rs.300/- for Local Levy) at the time of filling of Examination form of Semester-I Examination.
- (ii) Rs.2500/- for Dissertation Evaluation fee at the time of filling of Examination Form of Semester-II Examination.

- (iii) Rs.100/- for Provisional Certificate at the time of filling of Examination Form of Semester – II Examination.
- (iv) Rs.600/- for Degree Certificate at the time of filling of Examination Form of Semester –II Examination .

10. Duties of the DRC:

Duties and function of DRC in implementing the M.Phil. programme will be as under.

- 10.1 To guide the teachers in selection of topic for dissertation based on project/ design work or on the identified area of research.
- 10.2 To constitute Board of Studies to draw the syllabus / courses of studies for the course work and to review / amend the same periodically.
- 10.3 To recommend methods for improving the teaching and guiding to M.Phil. students.
- 10.4 To recommend the names of examiners for theory papers as well as dissertation to the University.
- 10.5 To approve dissertation of the students for evaluation.

11. Number of Students Per Guide

Normally not more than five M.Phil. students shall be assigned to any individual teacher for the purpose of guiding the dissertation work. Each teacher shall be normally expected to devote at least two hours per week for each student assigned to him/her for guiding the dissertation.

12. Registration

- 12.1 Every student admitted in M.Phil. Course must be registered as student of the University except those already registered with Ranchi University. External students must submit their Migration Certificate in original along with the registration form at the time of admission itself. Old students of Ranchi University who have taken migration are required to be re-registered. The process of registration must be completed within three months of the date of admission. No student will be allowed to appear at the Semester – I examination without registration.

13. Other Guidelines

- 13.1 No student will be allowed to appear more than twice in Semester-I.
- 13.2 The dissertation under Semester-II may not be submitted more than thrice.
- 13.3 The student must clear the M.Phil. Examination within three years of the initial registration for M.Phil. Programme.

13.4 The students obtaining the qualifying marks of 60% in aggregate at the M. Phil. Examination shall be allowed to undertake research work leading to the Ph.D. Degree of Ranchi University subject to the fulfillment of Ph.D. Regulation and availability of Guides in the subject.

14. **Dispute Resolution**

14.1 Whenever any dispute arises regarding interpretation of the provision/s of this rule the interpretation given by the Examination Board of the University will be final and overriding.

14.2 If any matter relating to M.Phil. Programme is not covered by this rule the Examination Board shall have the power to take such steps as it deems appropriate for maintaining the standard and quality of the M.Phil. Programme.

15. **Amendments**

15.1 Any amendment to any clause of the regulation may be brought about in accordance with Provisions laid down in the JSU Act 2000 as amended up-to-date.

16. **Repeal and Savings**

This regulation shall come into force with effect from the date of issuance of the Regulation.
